Barbour County Circuit Clerk's Office - Policy for resuming limited public access

The Barbour County Commission has decided to resume limited public access to the Barbour County Courthouse on May 26, 2020. Because the number of people allowed to enter the Courthouse at any one time will be limited, it is highly recommended that any person wishing to visit the Circuit Clerk's office to file court papers or transact other official business should call first to make an appointment. Except for emergencies, anyone coming to the Courthouse to visit the Circuit Clerk's office without an appointment may be required to wait in their car or come back at a later day or time unless the Clerk or a Deputy Clerk is available to meet with that visitor. All visitors will be required to comply with County Commission rules requiring masks, social distancing and other protective measures.
